

NORTHERN STUDENT TEACHER BURSARY

LIVING IN THE NORTH IS NOT FOR EVERYONE (but it just might be right for you)

Take your teaching career to a whole new level – go north where you'll enjoy variety, challenge and a warm welcome. Plus, you may have **a job lined up even before you even graduate!** Northern Alberta offers a wide range of settings and experiences. Alberta Education and the Northern Alberta Development Council (NADC) can help you make it happen. This bursary of up to \$16,000 is for an education program student in either of their last two years of study (\$8,000 per year).

You may be eligible for a Northern Student Teacher Bursary (NSTB) if you:

- are a Canadian citizen enrolled full-time in a post-secondary program at a designated institution (residents of Alberta will be given preference), and
- are in **either of your last two years** of a Bachelor of Education degree with a specialty that is currently in high demand in the north. (See page 4, question 1.)

You increase your chance of success if:

- you complete the application fully and answer the essay questions clearly and concisely,
- you demonstrate an interest in northern Alberta and knowledge of northern employment opportunities, and
- you have an acceptable academic record and have attached a copy of your latest transcript.

The return service commitment:

Upon graduation students who receive a bursary must **successfully secure employment as a teacher and live and work in one of the 21 participating school divisions to fulfill NSTB requirements.** Students commit to employment as a teacher in northern Alberta for three full-time years (or equivalent) in return for two years of bursary funding, or two full-time years (or equivalent) return of service for one year of bursary funding. Recipients who do not fulfill this requirement must repay the bursary.

All applicants will be advised of their status in January.

Important Notes:

- Applications sent by email or fax are not accepted.
- Students can only receive one of the following bursaries per academic year
 - Northern Student Teacher Bursary
 - NADC Bursary
 - NADC First Nation, Metis and Inuit Bursary.
